COLLEGE INTERVIEW PROCESS AND REQUIREMENTS:

Try not to panic about your college interview, it is a very informal process which will last up to 30 minutes.

During the interview you will:

- discuss your application and assess whether the subjects you have chosen are the right choice for you.
- check if you have applied for the right level of course/s.
- look at your predicted grades.
- discuss why you have applied for the course and what your aspirations are.
- talk about any medical or support needs you may have.
- look at your personal statement and chat about your interests and hobbies.
- ask any questions you are unsure about.
- be informed about lots of information regarding transport, enrichments, student life etc.

Ensure you:

- dress smartly.
- arrive on time.
- go prepared—do your research beforehand.
- take a copy of your predicted grades / past school reports.
- take any other evidence of achievements with your compensation of
