### Dear parents and carers

We're delighted to hear that your child will be joining us in September and we look forward to welcoming you both to our school community. As a parent myself, I know that you have made a very important decision in entrusting us with your child's education. We take this responsibility very seriously and will do all we possibly can to help them become an important part of our school community and provide them with everything they need to make a really strong start to their time at Nova.

#### **High Standards**

We know that parents select Nova because we are a school with clear values and high standards. Our values of Hard Work, Excellence and Kindness run throughout everything that we do as a school. We seek to reward students regularly for demonstrating these values through awarding Merits. On average we award over 10,000 Merits a week. There are regular reward events and prizes for students based on Merit awards.

## **High Achievement**

It is our aim that we will give every child who attends Nova the best possible chance of success, both during their time at Nova and beyond. We do this by ensuring that:

- Students gain high value qualifications which will open as many doors for them in the future as possible
- Students develop a real understanding of subject disciplines, learning knowledge and ways of thinking that take them beyond everyday understanding enabling them to better participate in our democratic society
- Students get the opportunity to take part in many high quality experiences trips, visits, clubs and events which allow them to flourish outside the classroom, developing their character.

#### **Education with Character**

We firmly believe in the importance of education with character. Our annual survey highlights just how much our students appreciate SuperNova, our extensive extra-curricular offer. They have the opportunity to take part in fantastic events, including the Swindon Youth Festival of Literature, theatre trips and exhibitions such as The Big Bang Fair in Bristol. All year 8 students have the opportunity to experience a residential camping trip and our students also get the opportunity to go on other residential visits, including a ski trip to the French Alps. They also enjoy taking part in a whole host of sports teams and school productions.















#### Ofsted

At the last Ofsted inspection, the Inspectors recognised that Nova Hreod "continues to be a good school."

The inspection highlights many of our strengths including that:

- We are a "friendly and welcoming school".
- We provide a "calm and purposeful learning environment" for our children.
- Children, including those with special educational needs and disabilities, are able to enjoy a "rich and ambitious curriculum."
- Pupils "take pride in the work they produce."
- Staff build up a detailed picture of individual pupils and the support they need. When appropriate, leaders work effectively with external agencies to secure timely help for pupils.
- Our Super Nova enrichment programme which supports children's wider personal development and a "detailed programme of careers advice for pupils of all years."

#### **Catalyst STEM Stream**

If your child has an academic aptitude for STEM (science, technology, engineering, maths) or computing, they can apply to join the Catalyst STEM Stream at Nova. Students in Catalyst Stream will benefit from an enhanced STEM curriculum and enjoy unique opportunities to develop their interests and reach their ambitions.

There are 30 spaces available on the Catalyst Stream; applicants will need to pass an assessment and attend an informal interview where they will demonstrate their knowledge of a STEM subject of their choice.
