

Learning from Home

Year 10

All students are expected to check EPRAISE **by 9.15am every school day** to see what work has been set for them, then working quietly and studiously on this work for the time they would normally be in lessons.

It is imperative that the circumstances we face, do not impede our students' academic progression, and that they continue to make excellent progress at home, as they would in school.

Year 10 students should complete their English, maths and science work as well as work which is set by their option subject teachers. Each session of work should take approximately an hour. As you know, they can now come into school for one morning each week.

Timetable of Work

Now that school is open to Year 10 once a week, the timetable for home learning has changed in some ways.

- For English, mathematics and science: all home learning tasks for the week will be set on a Monday with a due date of the Friday of the same week. This is to allow students to manage their time on these subjects according to their morning in school. There are 3 home learning tasks each for English and maths, and 4 for science. The time in school does not replace home learning.
- Options subjects are continuing to set three home learning work tasks each week. In some options subjects, teachers are hosting online classrooms (see separate communication on this) in the afternoons. Not all options subjects are doing this, setting combinations of videos, written tasks, quizzes and so forth for home learning tasks.
