Year 11 Geography Revision Sessions

We are writing to let you know about an additional revision opportunity that the Geography team will be providing for all Year 11 Geography students.

As our students prepare for their **first mock examinations in November**, it is important that they begin developing effective revision habits and regularly revisiting the knowledge and skills they have covered. More importantly, these sessions will help students prepare thoroughly for their **summer GCSE examinations**, which will be a significant milestone in their secondary education.

The Geography team will be running a weekly revision session every **Tuesday from 4:00–5:00pm in FE10 starting 22nd September**. Students will have the opportunity to revise key topics, practise exam questions and develop their examination technique, with **three Geography teachers available each week to provide support and guidance**.

We strongly encourage all Year 11 Geography students to attend these sessions regularly. Consistent attendance will give students the opportunity to identify areas that they are less confident with, ask questions and build their confidence ahead of their examinations.

We would greatly appreciate your support in encouraging your child to attend these sessions and make the most of this additional opportunity. Regular revision now will help students feel more confident and prepared when they sit their mock examinations in November and, ultimately, their GCSE examinations in the summer.
