

YEAR 8 ESSENTIAL CAMP KIT LIST *Note: All items should be labelled with at least students initials.*

All kit is to be packed in **one** holdall or rucksack

A **packed lunch is needed for the first day**, students entitled to free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch. All food is provided for the rest of the trip

We recommend **pocket money of £10** (the only place to spend money is a small tuck shop on one evening) to be brought in £1 coins in an envelope labelled with student's name.

No mobile phones – there is nowhere safe to keep these so if they are brought it is at their own risk

No jewellery – if students do bring jewellery, it is at their own risk

No electrical equipment such as MP3 players, hairdryers etc (there isn't anywhere to plug them in)

Trousers e.g.jogging / combat/ track suit/ leggings (NO JEANS)	4

Warm hat & gloves/sunhat (weather dependent)	1
Footwear (trainers) for dry activities	2
Footwear for inside tent (flip flops/sliders) desirable	1
Sleeping bag (or duvet secured with a belt inside a carrier bag)	1
Small pillow	1
Torch & spare batteries	1
Small rucksack to carry to activities	1
Bin liners/ carrier bag for dirty / wet clothing	2
Towel and flannel	1
Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, shower gel, deodorant)	1
Sun cream (the school will bring a certain amount of Sensitive F50)	1
Water bottle (this can then be refilled as necessary)	1
