2024-2025 INSET Days

Equipment Update

There have been no changes to the policy since the start of the school year. However, I would like to give a reminder of the following points in our policy which can sometimes be areas of contention with students following a holiday:

- No nail varnish, gel, acrylic or artificial nails may be worn by students at Nova

- Nose piercings are not permitted; however, students may wear transparent flat retainers for a single nose piercing.
