

Physical and sensory

The difficulties your young person may face with a sensory and physical need may show;

- Difficulties with vision that cannot be corrected from regular prescribed aid (glasses)
- Challenges with hearing, this would include diagnosed partial/full hearing impairment
- Impediments with fine and gross motor co-ordination
- Difficulties will also include diagnosed conditions or challenges strongly associated with Cerebral palsy, Physical injury or disabilities as well as dyspraxia
- There are some sensory related difficulties associated with communication and interaction (ASD/Asperger's Syndrome) however the interaction barrier is the primary need.

Please be aware that further support is made available to targeted students in small groups or 1:1, this level of support is agreed on an individual basis and will be discussed with parents and school leaders. A student receiving additional support will be monitored and the support reviewed regularly to ensure appropriate application and positive impact.
